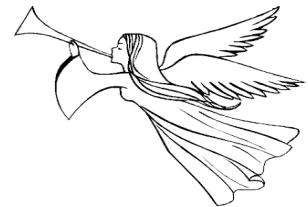
## **Pie Fundraiser**
