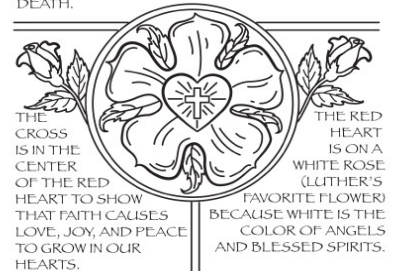
Jazz Band to Trinity
